


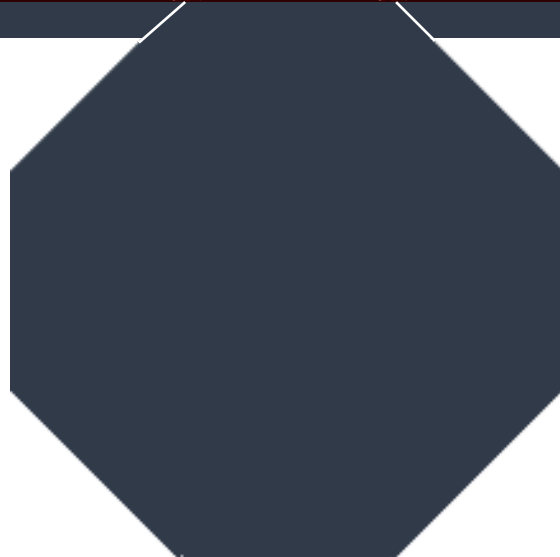
HAUNTED MANSION STRETCHING ROOM DIORAMA

STEP 1: Cut out stretching room; Follow the solid color lines of the image. Be sure NOT to cut off the brown and blue tabs. Cut notches through the 4 diagonal lines between the tabs that are connected to the floor and ceiling

STEP 2: Fold the wall corners inward. The notches that you just made also indicate the fold line of each pillar. In total, there are eight pillars to fold.

STEP 3: Fold all the brown and blue tabs inward, so that the printed side of the tabs is facing the printed side of the room.

STEP 4: Using a hole punch, punch a hole through the tiny black "x" on the brown paneling of walls "C" and "D." NOTE: To maintain the best possible diorama effect, you may only want to punch one hole. If so, select the two portraits (they must be next to each other) you would like to view when looking into room. Then, punch a hole on the wall which would be directly across the room. Example: If, when looking in, you would like to see the Tightrope Walker and the Dynamite Man, punch the hole on wall "C." Also, if you choose to only punch one hole on one wall, you may want to make the hole a bit bigger to allow for a larger view.

STEP 5: Using double-sided tape or glue, join sides A and B together. Note: side B should overlap side A so that the gargoyle/beam is visible.

STEP 6: Apply double-sided tape or glue to the **printed** side of each blue tab. Press down tabs on the unprinted side of the floor.

STEP 7: Apply double-sided tape or glue to the **unprinted** side of each brown tab. Press down ceiling and meet with each of the taped or glued tabs.
